

# Oberon High School

## Works notification | 5 March 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

We are pleased to advise that as part of our regular maintenance schedule, a project is underway in Building F at Oberon High School to provide refurbished toilets.

As part of this work, we will be removing known bonded asbestos from the toilet partitions. This area is listed on the School's Asbestos Management Plan and will be restricted and locked as part of the construction zone to staff and students.

Staff and students will have access to other toilet facilities available within the school

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All asbestos-containing material will be removed between Friday 27 March and Sunday 29 March 2026. Work hours are between 7 am and 7 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday.

An independent hygienist has been engaged to oversee the work and conduct air monitoring and testing following the removal of asbestos-containing materials. A clearance certificate will be provided before refurbishment works starts during the Autumn School Holidays and extend into early Term 2 2026.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws as well as the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
