Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are replacing the carpet in a classroom in Building A and in a classroom and a movement area in Building F at Granville Boys High School.

The tile adhesive under the current floor coverings is known to contain bonded asbestos and is listed on the school's asbestos register.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will take place on the evenings of Friday 12 June and Friday 19 June 2026. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
