Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The NSW government is committed to offering all families a co-educational high school option by 2027. Following extensive community consultation in Term 3 of 2022, it was determined that Penshurst Girls and Hurstville Boys in the Georges River College would each become co-educational campuses from 2025.

Each campus will undergo works to refurbish and upgrade elements of the school as part of the co-educational transition for Georges River College. These upgrades will improve the facilities available to students and teachers and ensure each school is well equipped to meet the needs of the changing enrolments.

Overview of upgrades at Georges River College, Hurstville Campus

The Hurstville Boys Campus of Georges River College will undergo a reconfiguration and refurbishment of the existing boys' toilets in Block II. This will create 2 separate facilities, one for boys and one for girls, within the existing floor space.

There will also be new accessible change facilities installed in Block D.

The contract was awarded to Ages Build Pty Ltd and works commenced on Thursday 28 November.
