Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment, we are pleased to advise that the tender has been awarded for covered walkway replacements at the Hunter School of Performing Arts.

This work will improve the durability and sustainability of 2 covered walkways, reducing the likelihood of leaks. These 2 walkways are located between buildings A and G, and the other is attached to Building J.

Due to contractor availability, we are starting these works in the upcoming Autumn holidays.

Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays and Term 2, 2025

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning. We will be working at your school during the Autumn School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 11 April continuing into Term 2 2025.

To prepare for the walkway replacements, the first stage will involve demolishing and removing the old structures. This removal work will be done in the upcoming school holiday period.
