

Ashfield Public School & Ashfield Boys High School

Works notification | 10 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are undertaking work to improve the facilities available for students and staff at Ashfield Public School and Ashfield Boys High School.

Ashfield Public School

We are completing an electrical upgrade at Ashfield Public School to improve functionality for students and staff.

This work involves drilling into concrete and brick surfaces, cutting concrete and excavating some areas of the school site.

Any work that requires the shutdown of power will be done outside of school hours to minimise disruption to school operations.

Work on the electrical upgrade is underway and expected to be finished before the end of Term 4.

We will also be installing acoustic panelling on the demountable closest to the boundary of Ashfield Boys High School to help reduce noise transfer before and after installation of a new lift.

Ashfield Boys High School

To increase accessibility for students and staff, we are installing an external passenger lift in Block G (the science building) at Ashfield Boys High School.

This work involves minor excavation and demolition, and the construction of concrete paths and ramps.

Safety measures including temporary fencing, construction site hoarding and signage have been installed. These will remain in place while works are being carried out.

Work is underway and expected to be finished in early 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

The classrooms within Building G will remain operational throughout the work.

Construction work hours

Work hours on both sites are Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturdays 8 am to 1 pm. Where possible all noisy work will be conducted outside of class times to minimise disruption to students and staff.
