Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will be completing upgrades at Dulwich High School of Visual Arts and Design. These improvements include:

- installing a new electrical substation to provide a stronger and more reliable power supply.
- upgrading the school's overall electricity system to ensure safe and steady power for all buildings.
- adding new air conditioning units to classrooms throughout the school to keep students and staff comfortable.
- replacing the old air conditioning system in the library with a new, efficient one for better cooling.

As technology continues to play an important role in teaching and learning, these improvements will modernise the electrical system throughout the school to meet current and future needs.

The new air conditioning system will upgrade the existing units across the school, providing a more comfortable learning environment for students and staff year-round.

This period may include from the end of the school day on Friday 25 September 2026 up to the first day of Term 1, Thursday 4 February 2027, weather and site permitting.

Work hours

Air conditioning installation will take place between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday.

There may be some construction noise while electrical works are happening. We will make every effort to minimise any disruption to learning during this time.
