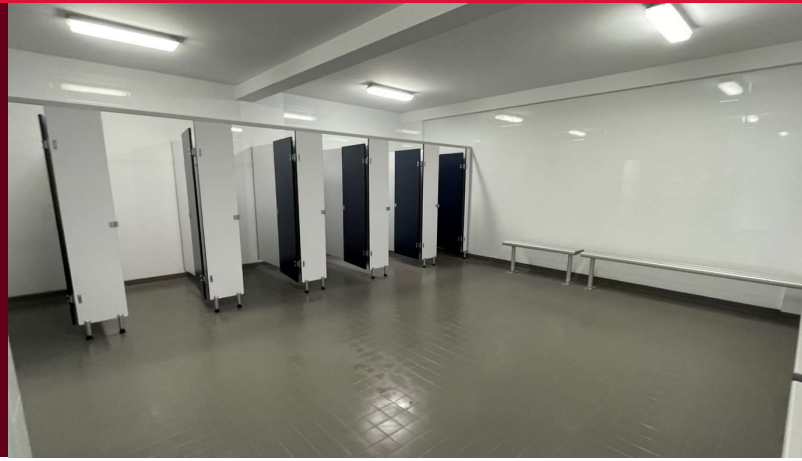

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment, Balgowlah Boys is receiving upgrades to its facilities. The Building C gymnasium toilets and change room facilities are being redeveloped. The works include:

- demolition and removal of existing facilities
- complete new fitout of toilet and change room facilities:
 - new walls and floor tiles
 - new bathroom fixtures, toilets, urinals, basins and tapware
 - new cubicles suites
 - new seating for students
 - new auto sensor LED lighting
 - painting upgrades.

Progress summary

Planning for the gymnasium toilets and change rooms in Building C to be replaced and upgraded is underway, improving privacy and comfort for student use.

These works are in addition to other enhancements Balgowlah Boys is receiving, funded by the school and its community which includes:

- gymnasium sound baffling installation
- new shade sail
- music room refurbishment.

The contract for the toilet and change room project is expected to be awarded later this year. Once the contract is awarded, demolition will start. The school community will be kept updated as these works progress. The department will continue to work with the school to identify and plan its priority infrastructure works for the school.
