Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to refurbish the library at The Jannali High School in partnership with the school's Parents and Citizens Association.

This project was approved in early March 2026 and will deliver to all areas of the library, a total of 14 rooms:



New furniture and fit-out



New carpet



Repainting of internal spaces

Next steps

The project will begin on Tuesday 7 April 2026.

This project, which includes new library furniture, is expected to be completed by mid-May 2026. The improvements will benefit the school community for many years to come.
