Works notification | 7 March 2023

A project is underway at James Cook Boys Technology High School. The project will provide a refurbished staff toilet in Building A and convert an existing storeroom into a new staff toilet in Building E.

Remediation activities

As part of this project, upcoming maintenance works to replace the vinyl floor tiles at James Cook Boys Technology High School will involve working with asbestos containing material in Building A and E.

Work to remove the material will take place on Saturday 11 March 2023. All asbestos containing material will be removed outside of school hours and in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

The areas will be cordoned off before works start, and safety measures and monitoring put in place. They will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected to ensure they have been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are re-opened to staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
