

Epping Boys High School

Works notification | 18 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 16 September, 3 fragments of building material suspected to contain asbestos were found in the staff carpark in front of B Block at Epping Boys High School, and have since been removed.

The area was immediately isolated after the fragments were found. An independent hygienist was engaged to remove the fragments, undertake air monitoring and test one sample.

Test results confirmed the sample contained bonded asbestos material.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The independent hygienist has since issued a clearance certificate for the area to be reopened.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
