Toronto High School Works notification | 27 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Suspected mould was found in 2 classrooms in the Administration Building at Toronto High School. This was due to excess moisture from the subfloor under the rooms after heavy rain.

The rooms were temporarily isolated until repairs and cleaning could be carried out. Students and staff were provided with alternative classrooms during this time.

Remediation work includes an environmental clean of the areas with air scrubbers (a type of filtration device), dehumidifiers and exhaust fans in place.

This work will be completed between 7 am and 2.30 pm from Tuesday 27 to Friday 30 May 2025, with appropriate safety measures in place. Rooms are due to reopen in the week starting Monday 2 June.

A licensed contractor will return to inspect the room and repair the subfloor if required before the rooms are reopened for use.


Please be aware of the preventative measures as advised by <u>NSW Health's mould factsheet</u> to help avoid mould growth and follow these steps as best you can.
