Works notification | 28 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are converting 2 classrooms into a new science lab in Building C at Cammeraygal High School. To prepare for this work we are removing ceiling panels confirmed to contain bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Work involving the removal of asbestos-containing materials will be completed on Saturday 7 June 2025 with safety measures in place such as air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The entire conversion is due to be finished around August 2025. These rooms will remain closed within a construction zone until the project is completed. Students and staff will have access to alternative classrooms during this period.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
