

# **Empire Vale Public School**

Project update | March 2024

## **Project overview**

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood impacted schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with more flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Empire Vale Public School, which was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022.

The project will deliver new modern flood resilient classrooms and school facilities, including a library, canteen, administration area, undercover learning area, yarning circle and landscaping to complement the school's surroundings.

#### **Progress summary**

- Demolition of the old school was completed during the summer school holidays. The heritage building still remains.
- The screw piles are almost complete. These are long steel columns that will form the base of foundations for the new building.
- Footings have begun in preparation for the pouring of the concrete slab.
- The storm water and septic services have been installed.
- A sod turning and Welcome to Country was held with school leaders on 31 January 2024 to mark the start of construction.
- Detailed design of the school space and landscaping have been finalised in consultation with the Project Reference Group (PRG).
- Feedback from our Connecting with Country consultation in late 2023 is also being incorporated into the rebuilt school.
- Offsite construction of the new school buildings is about 70% complete (see attached photos).

#### Next steps

• The off-site construction will continue. Once the buildings are complete, they will be dismantled and transported to Empire Vale for installation. This may impact local roads, including River Drive. We will advise the community ahead of time.
