Project Update | September 2023

What is happening at Blakebrook Public School?

A project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. The project will deliver new modern and flexible learning environments and core facilities that will support the long term needs of the local community. Students will continue learning from temporary demountable classrooms at Blakebrook Public School while the school is being rebuilt.

Current Status

- Master planning and concept design is complete.
- An information session will be held at the Blakebrook Public School on 26 October 2023 at 4:30pm. Invitations will be sent out from the school on during the first week back in Term 4.
- New play equipment has been purchased and is scheduled be installed during December this year. An example of the play equipment is shown on the next page.

Next Steps

- Commence schematic design and planning application submitted.

Completion is expected in 2024 but will depend on the planning approval, builder's schedule, weather and site conditions and the availability of resources. We will do whatever we can to complete the project sooner and we thank you and the school community for your patience.
