Remediation and Repair Update

November 2022

What is happening at Maclean High School?

A project is underway to deliver remediation and repair works to Maclean High School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. The project will deliver refurbished and flexible learning environments that will support the long term needs of the local community. The school grounds which were also damaged by the flood, will be repaired. Students are learning in unaffected learning spaces and facilities as normal.

Current Status

- Agricultural facilities and buildings exposed to torrential rain are undergoing deep cleaning and mould remediation.
- Scaffolding and hoarding have been installed around the library in preparation for the replacement of the library school roof.

Next steps

A public information session was held November 9, 2022, at Maclean High School, providing information about the multiple program of works currently underway at the school. The forecast completion of the flood works program is by Term 2, 2023, pending site and weather conditions, and availability of resources.

What else is happening in the region?

With the cleaning and 'make safe' stage complete, students have been face-to-face learning either at their own school site in permanent or temporary buildings, or at an alternate site in temporary demountable classrooms since the end of Term 1, 2022. As refurbishment and repair works progress, damaged facilities are being returned to affected schools for normal use. In addition to the remediation and repair program for the seven schools being managed by Public Works, nine schools are in the planning stages of being rebuilt.
