## Summer Break Construction Activities

School Infrastructure NSW and Public Works are managing the repair and remediation of buildings and grounds at Maclean High School

### Construction work dates

Flood remediation work will temporarily shut down for the summer break on **Friday 23 December 2022**, and will resume on **Monday 9 January 2023**.

Access to the school will be maintained at all times.

Work hours will be **Monday to Friday 7am to 5pm, and Saturday 7am to 5pm**.

### Construction activities

Work to be undertaken during the summer break include:

- Teachers' entry path and stair replacement
- Roof replacement and internal refurbishment of Block C (support unit and classrooms)
- Installation of hoarding to disabled ramps at Block B (administration and classrooms)
- Internal refurbishment and storm water upgrade to Block A (administration and classrooms)
- Pavement reinstatement at school entry
- Dismantling of Block R (shed)
- Refurbishment of Block O (agricultural workshop)

An AQF5 qualified arborist was engaged to assess necessary vegetation removal. We were not able to remove one dead tree, five trees with roots that are damaging school infrastructure, and vegetation overhanging buildings and pathways, during the September 2022 holidays. This will now take place over the summer break. We will replant two local native trees for every tree we remove, with species specified by Maclean Clarence Valley Council.

There may be some noise associated with these works. We will make every effort to minimise noise impacts by, for example, turning off machinery when not in use.

The health, safety and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
